Lesson 9: Boost Spelling and Vocabulary with Spectrum Workbooks

Learning Objectives

- 3 Day 3 Context & Proof: Use words in sentences and peer-check for clarity and accuracy.
- 4 Day 4 Study Games: Use flashcards, speed sorts, or cloze activities to reinforce patterns.
- 5 Day 5 Spiral Review & Quiz: Conduct a short oral or written quiz, reviewing missed words.

Differentiation

- Support: Focus on fewer words and use color-coded affixes for visual clarity.
- On-Level: Work with full lists plus one extension challenge word.
- Advanced: Add Greek/Latin roots and track derivatives (e.g., compose → composition).

Assessment & Progress

- Weekly dictation quiz and sentence usage check.
- Notebook review for morphology maps and word sorts.
- Mastery tracker for consistent word recall after 3 perfect reviews.

Extensions & Crossovers

- Writing: Compose a paragraph using at least 5 target words.
- Reading: Find and record pattern words from independent reading.
- Speaking: Present a 'Word of the Day' explaining meaning and usage.
